ACG meets Mayor of Bremen

Acting Consul General Dr. Vidhu P. Nair called on Mr. Jens Boehrnsen, Hon'ble Mayor and President of the Senate of the Free Hanseatic City of Bremen on February 19, 2014. Discussions were held in the Gobelin Room of the Bremen Town Hall where the bust of Mahatma Gandhi, donated by Indian government has been placed. Mayor Boehrnsen expressed his satisfaction over the longstanding partnership between Bremen and Indian city of Pune through Bremen-Pune Solidarity Forum. ACG pointed out that many Indian students were studying in the educational institutes in Bremen and that their number was likely to increase in the coming years. Mayor Boehrnsen highlighted Bremen's competence in renewable energy, aerospace industry, automobiles sector, food processing etc. He added that along with commercial relations, bilateral cooperation in S&T as well as R&D were also important. ACG requested Mayor Boehrnsen to undertake a visit to India at an early date. The meeting was held in a warm and cordial atmosphere marking the close bilateral relations enjoyed by both sides.

During the visit, ACG Nair also met Mr. Christian Weber, President of Bremen State Legislature as well as Vice President and Managing Director of the Bremen Chamber of Commerce. Both sides explored ways of strengthening people to people contact as well as trade and commercial relations.
